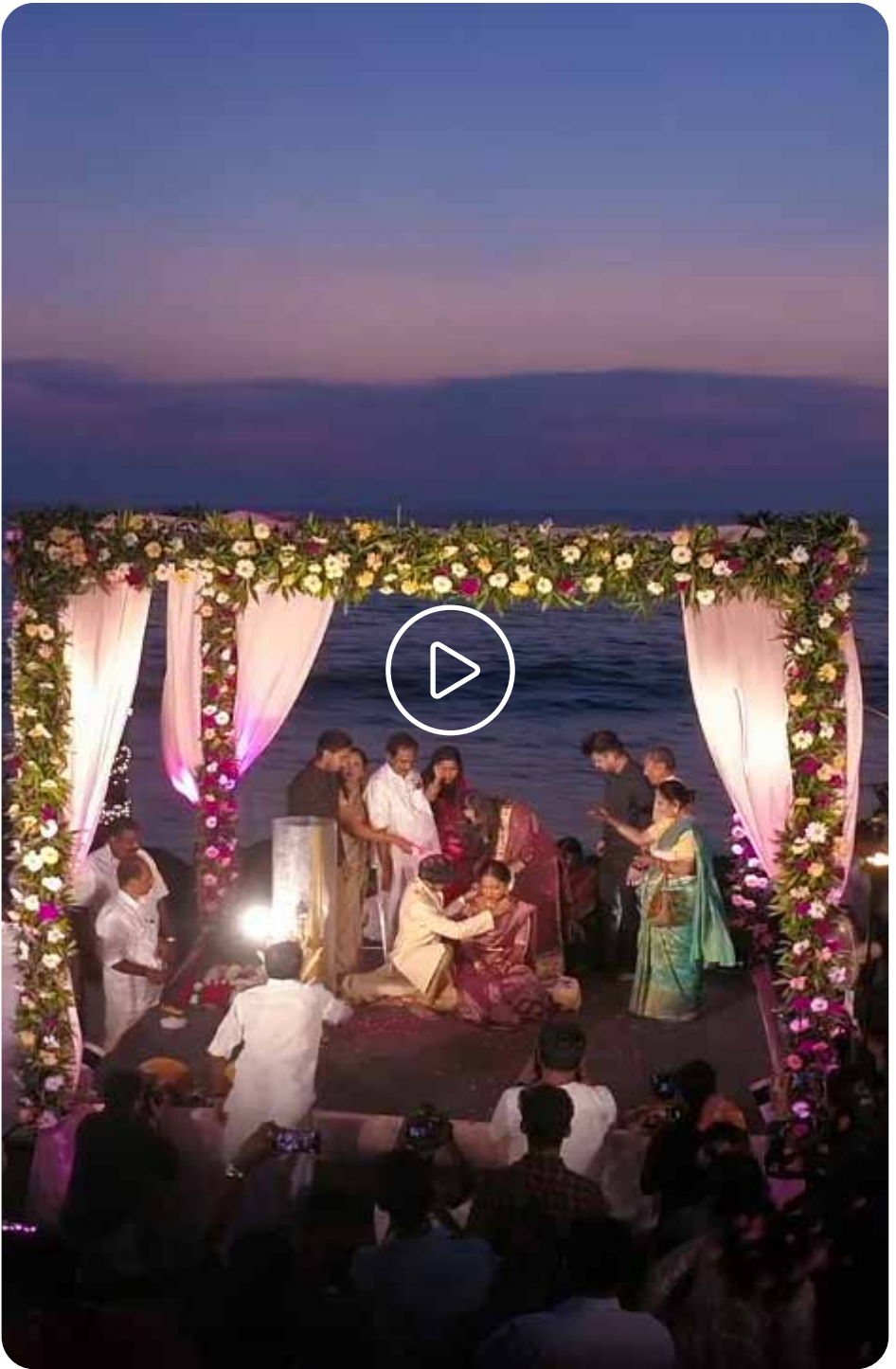

aboard a traditional 'Kettuvallam' (they are equipped with all modern amenities) is enough to send a thrill through your heart!

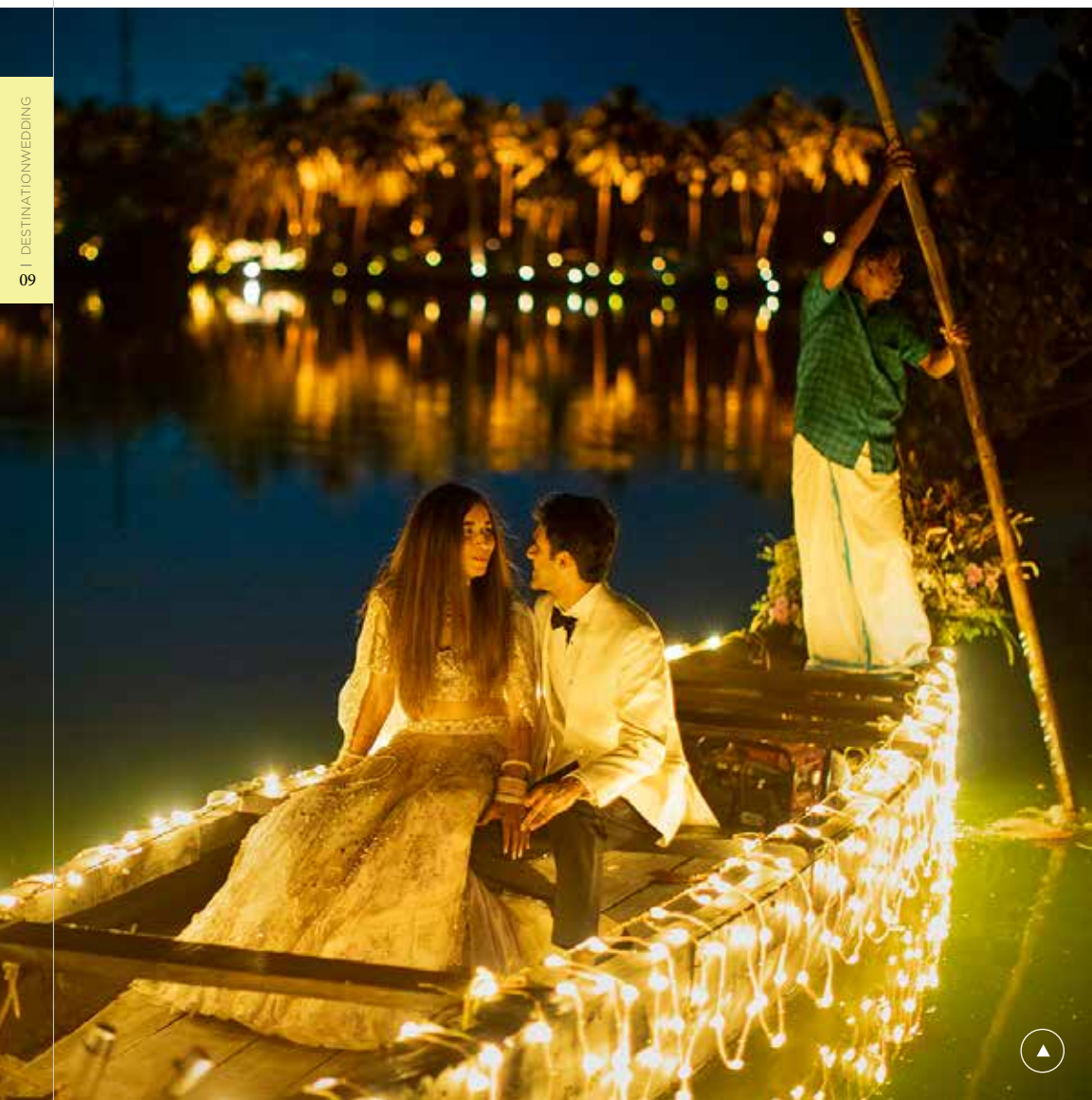

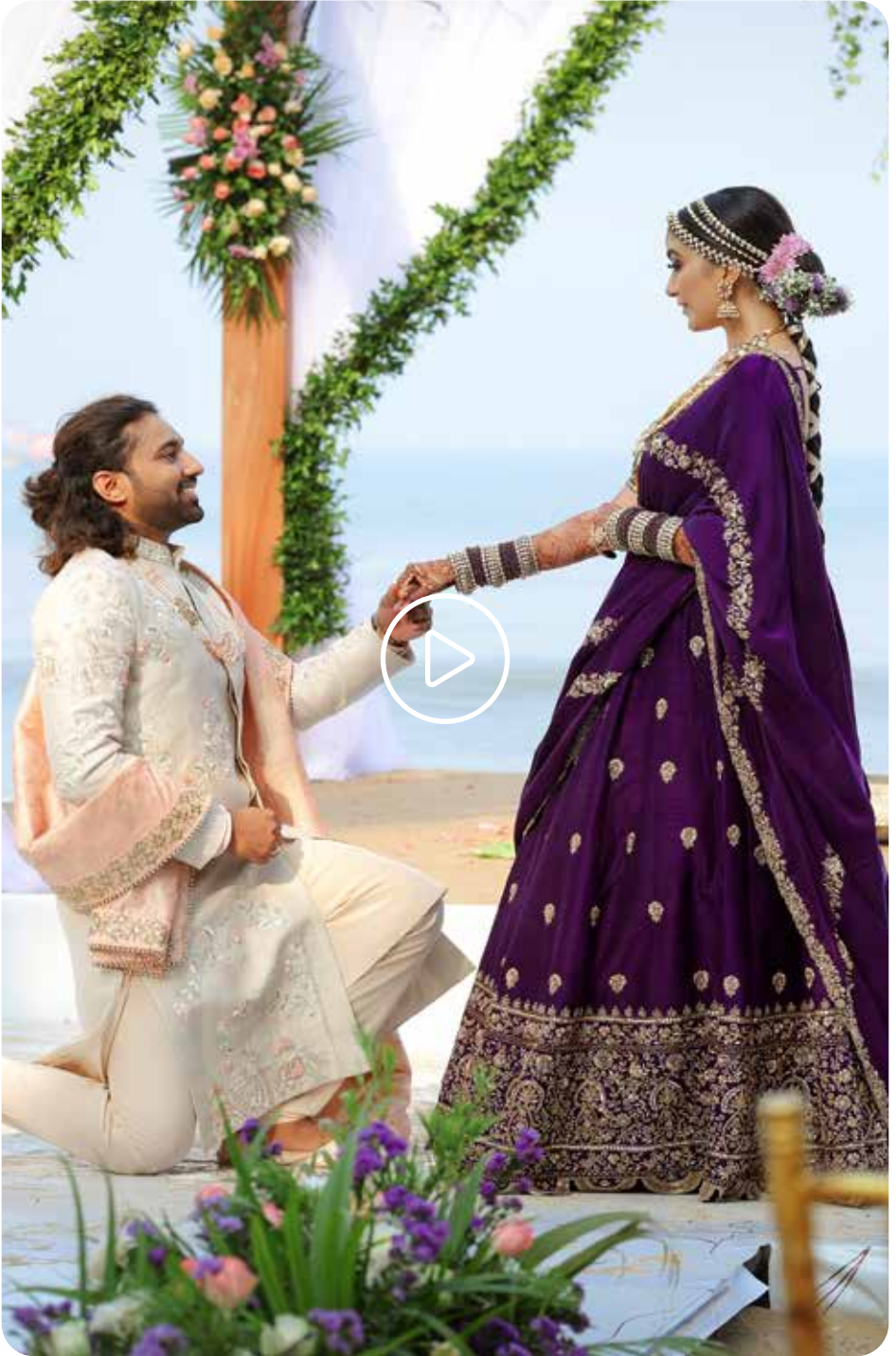
What better way to exchange vows than with the sea breeze in your hair, feet on silky sand and the symphony of the azure waves as BGM?

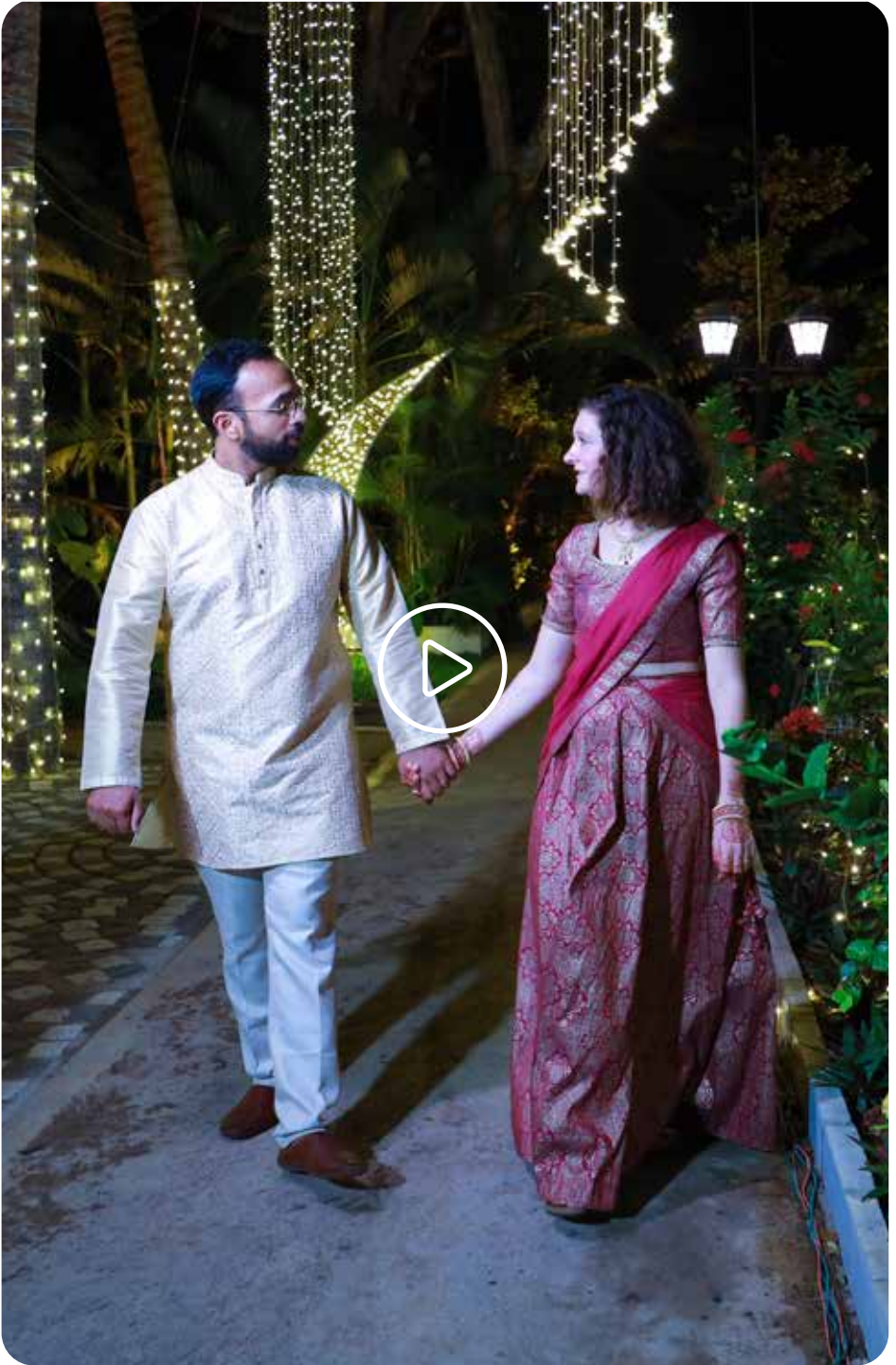

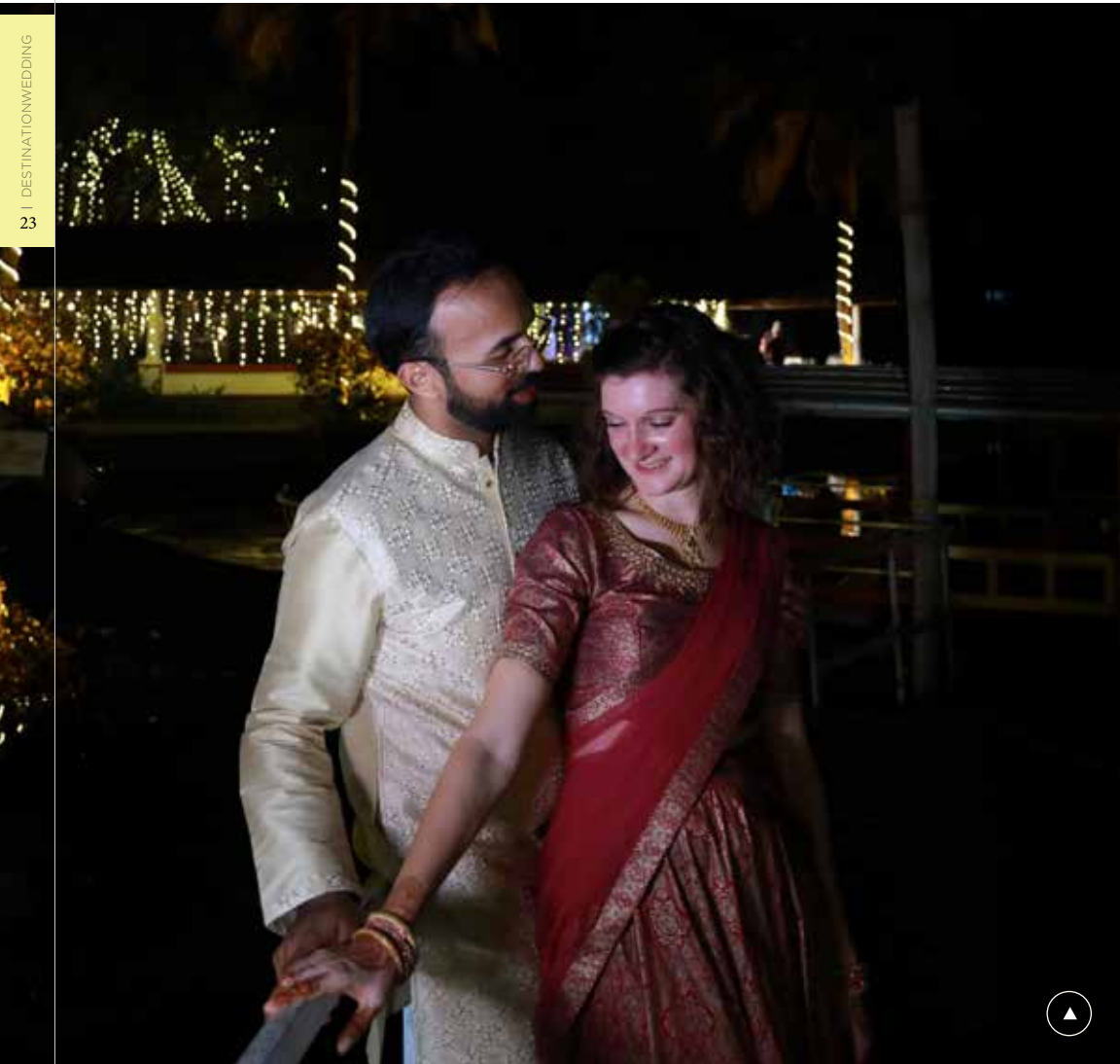

A meal that's an array of multiple flavors, textures, colours and aromas, the sadya is a testament to the cultural tapestry of God's Own Country.

More than just a meal, this gustatory and cultural experience takes you through nearly 28 different dishes in a single serving. This vegetarian feast that is usually served on a plantain leaf comprises dishes like aviyal, thoran, eriserry, upperi, pachadi, kichadi, sambar, parippu, pickle and so on that are served in a specific order. The wide range of vegetables, lentils and spices used in the preparation of this meal ensures that it is well-balanced and highly beneficial to your well-being as well. The careful selection and combination

of ingredients, especially that of cumin, ginger, garlic and turmeric, is designed to aid digestion as well as ensure mental, physical and spiritual wellness. The use of coconut in various forms in almost all the dishes adds to the unique and exquisite flavour-profile of each delicacy. The highlight of the Kerala sadya is 'payasam,' the dessert of the meal. The payasam has an almost pudding-like texture and is made with milk (or coconut milk), jaggery, cardamom, and other spices and garnished with roasted cashews and raisins.

The sadya should definitely be on your 'must-have' list as you head down to Kerala to celebrate your big day for it is an experience you don't want to miss out on. It is a feast, in the literal sense, not just for your tastebuds and appetite but also for every single one of your senses!
