Panmana Pooram is an annual festival conducted in Panmana Major Subramanya Swamy Temple. Panmana Major Subramanya Swamy Temple is known as the Pazhani of Kerala. This 11-day long festival which ends with Pooram or fireworks is conducted to celebrate the divine presence of the deity in the temple and seek the Lord's blessings for well-being and prosperity.

## DESCRIPTION (How festival is celebrated)

*Panmana Pooram* refers to the annual festival at the temple and *Pooram* in particlura refers to fireworks that are organized as part of the culmination of the festivities.. The highlight of the celebrations is dozens of caparisoned elephants and the change of parasols to the accompaniment of *Panchavadyam* and *Panchari melam*. Various other unique offerings are made at the shrine during the period of the festival. Traditional performing arts, music and dance are staged. The temple is traditionally decorated and illuminated with lamps and lights. The festival ends with *Arattu*. The *utsava murti* of the deity is taken out of the shrine for ritualistic bathing on the final day.
